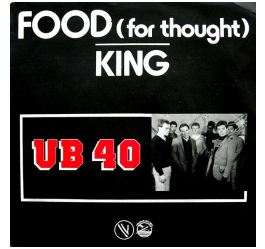

**Am E7 G D7** avec riff

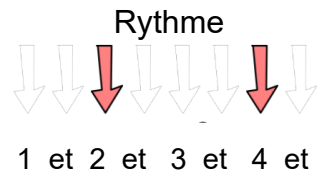
**Am** Skin and bones is creeping, **E7** doesn't know he's dead.
